NOLAN PILLAR SMITH KNOB MENDENHALL PEAK

THIEL MOUNTAINS - ANTARCTICA

These mountains, located at latitude 85° 15' S., and longitude 91° 00' W., were first sighted from a distance during Operation High Jump in February 1947.

Pictured above are Nolan Pillar, elevation 6,350 feet; Smith Knob, 7,000 feet; Mendenhall Peak, 7,000 feet; Mount Wrather, 6,850 feet; Mount Walcott, 7,050 feet; Mount Powell, 7,200 feet; and King Peak, 7,200 feet. Elevation of snow surface in the foreground, approximately 5,200 feet.

View is southeast by south. Distance from the camera to the peaks in the foreground is approximately eight miles.
